

ANCIENT EGYPTIAN RELIGION:

PHASE 2 PADLET INSTRUCTIONS

Logging in to Padlet:

1. Go to www.padlet.com
2. Sign up for a Padlet account using your student e-mail. You may click "SIGN UP WITH GOOGLE"
3. On the left side, click on +Make A New Padlet. Select "CANVAS."

Setting up your Padlet:

1. In "Modify Padlet" on the right side of the screen, title your padlet:
 - a. First & Last Name—Ancient Egyptian Religion Learning—Period #
2. Choose layout and wallpaper. Click the next button
3. Select "public" under People and Privacy. This will be shared with Mrs. Carson, so don't set it to "private" or "secret"
4. Select the option for "Those with Access" to be able to read your Padlet
5. Click the pink "Next" button and then "Start Posting"

Adding to your Padlet:

After completing your Phase 1 activity, you will select Padlet options to summarize and highlight your learning about religion in Ancient Egypt from the Phase 1 article and questions.

From the Bingo Board you must choose a group of options that would create a "bingo!" This means 3 boxes in a row- up, down, across, or diagonal. Depending on the options you select you will need to link or upload the different option to your Padlet in different ways—so pay attention to the directions!

Select options that demonstrate what you learned and found interesting. The options can be found on the back of this page.



Padlet Bingo Board Options

1. Use what you earned in your Phase 1 article (intro or experienced) to demonstrate what you learned about ancient Egyptian religion & mythology.
2. Complete the bingo board by choosing 3 boxes that would create a "Bingo!"
3. Complete and link each of your 3 options to your padlet board!

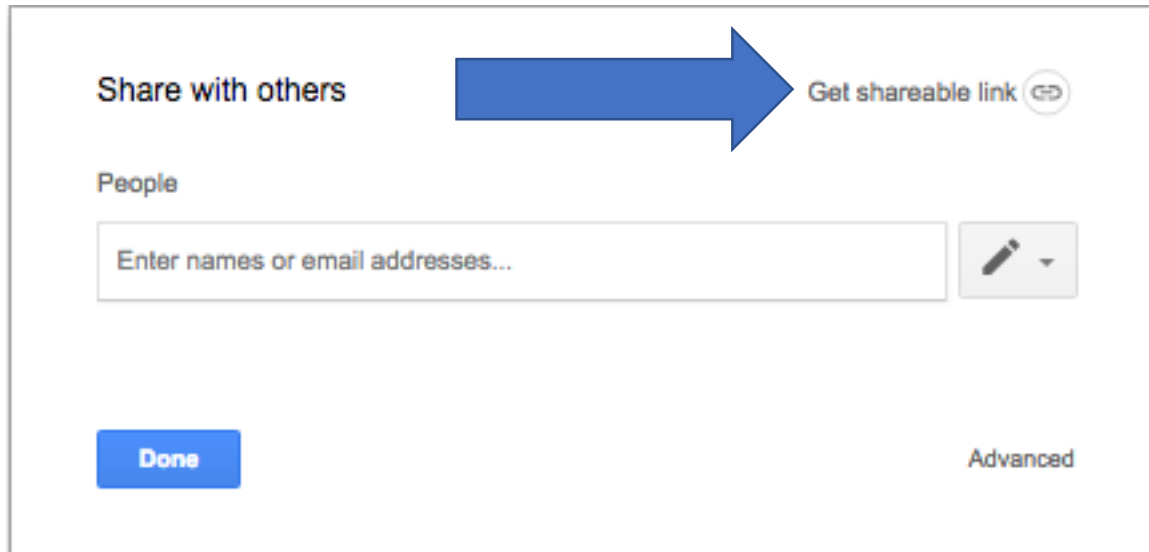
Get the 'share' link of your padlet board and paste it in your Google Classroom document.

<p>Quizlet Flashcards</p> <p>Create a digital set of flashcards on quizlet.com based on terms and topics from your learning in the phase 1 activity. Your set must have a minimum of 7 cards. You can upload pictures to your quizlet cards too!</p> <p>**Click the SHARE option when you are finished to get the link you need to add to a sticky on your padlet.**</p>	<p>Crossword Puzzle</p> <p>Create a crossword puddle with a minimum of 8 words and clues based on what you learned about Egyptian religion.</p> <p>**Use Puzzle-maker.com/cw Screenshot your puzzle and upload it on your Padlet board.**</p>	<p>Video Link & Summary</p> <p>Link 2 videos that supplement or add to your learning from your Phase 1 activity.</p> <p>You MUST include a description (use a Padlet sticky) that summarizes each video and how it connects to what you learned from your Phase 1 activity.</p>
<p>Info Stickies (Minimum 4)</p> <p>Stickies could...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Explain the importance of the topic to Egyptian life and religion -Explain why you found this topic/information interesting -make a connection to one or more GRAPES categories -relate/compare ancient Egyptian religion info. To religions/belief systems today 	<p>Word Cloud</p> <p>Create a word cloud that focuses on key ideas related to Egyptian religion and what you learned from Phase 1. Screenshot your word cloud and upload it to your Padlet board.</p> <p>Wordart.com Wordsift.org</p>	<p>Paragraph Reflection</p> <p>In a new google document, write a 1 paragraph reflection about what you learned or found interesting about Ancient Egyptian religion. Could include comparisons to today's world, connections to other GRAPES categories... be creative and thoughtful!</p> <p>**Make sure SHARING settings are set to "Anyone with link can view"**</p>
<p>Song Parody</p> <p>In a new Google Document, write new lyrics to the tune of a popular song based on what your learned in your phase one activity. Your song parody should include a verse and a chorus for whatever song you choose to parody. Link this Google Document to a sticky on your Padlet!</p> <p>**Make sure SHARING settings are set to "Anyone with link can view" **</p>	<p>Images & Captions</p> <p>Find 4 images that are appropriate and communicate information you learned about Ancient Egyptian religion.</p> <p>For each image, you MUST include an explanation of how the image connects to what you've learned (use a Padlet sticky).</p> <p>**Screenshot or save the images to your computer and then upload to your Padlet board.**</p>	<p>Google Form Quiz</p> <p>Create a short quiz on Google Forms (minimum of 5 questions) and link it to your Padlet with the "live" link. Access Google Forms from your Google Drive account.</p> <p>**Open a new form, go to the settings wheel > quizzes > slide button over to highlight "make this a quiz"</p>

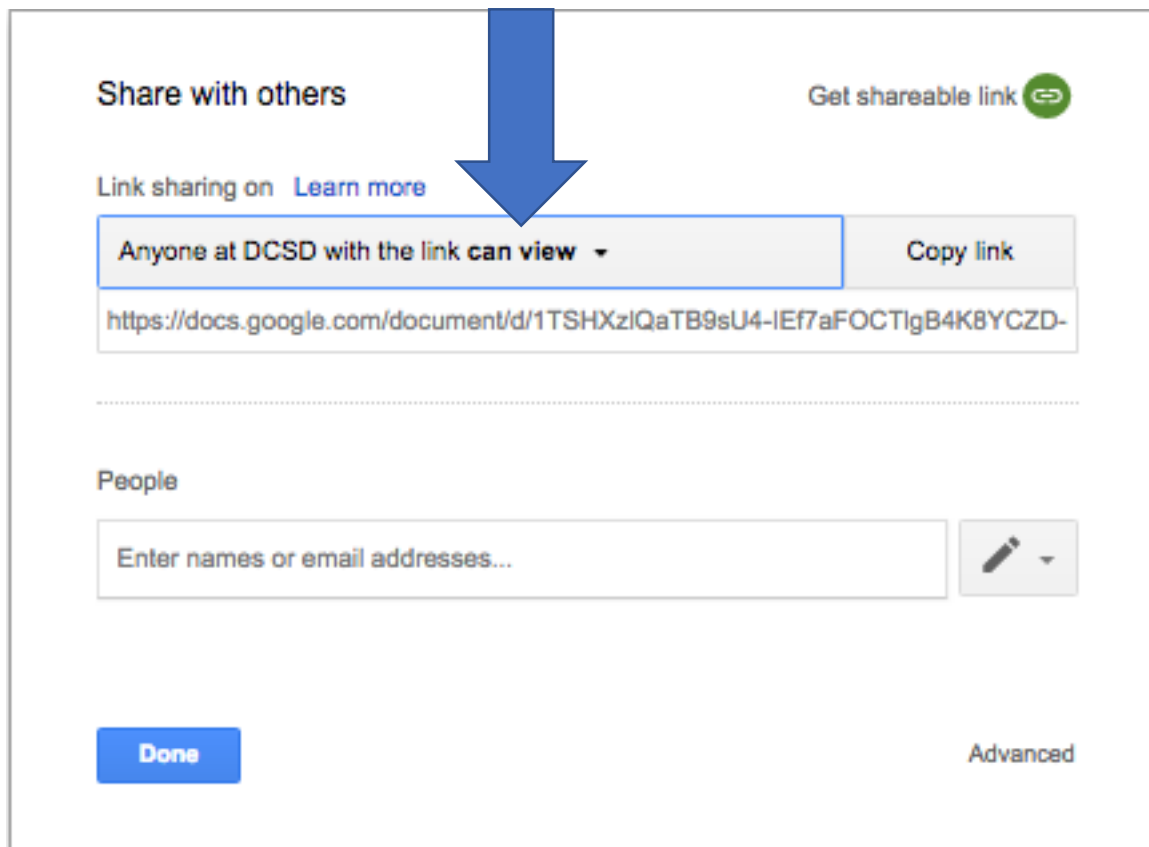


Google Doc/Form Options: Sharing settings

1. Click the blue “Share” button on your Google Doc.
For a Google Form Quiz, select the “Send” button and copy the link into a Padlet sticky.
2. In your Google Doc, click the “Get Shareable Link” icon (Should turn green)



3. **MAKE SURE** to click the drop-down menu and select “Anyone at DCSD with the link **can view**” Copy and paste the link to a sticky on your Padlet—Be sure to title the sticky.



Done? What to do with your Padlet:

When your Padlet is complete, copy and paste the Padlet's URL into your Egyptian Religion Google Classroom document (There is a spot to paste your link in the document). This will be a part of your Content Knowledge grade.

1. Click on "Share" at the top of your Padlet. Make sure the sidebar says "Share" at the top, if not then select the "Share/Export/Embed" option
2. Click on "Copy link to this Padlet." The link is copied. Go to your Google Classroom document and paste it where it is indicated in the document
3. If your Phase 1 activity and Phase 2 Padlet are done, submit your assignment via Google Classroom—Blue TURN IN button.
